

Resolution No. 2007-10
A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE TOWN OF STOCKBRIDGE
EXPANDED LAND USE ELEMENT

The Town Board of the Town of Stockbridge, Calumet County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to sections 60.22(3) and 62.23(2) and (3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Stockbridge is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2), Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2. The Town Board of the Town of Stockbridge has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3. The Town of Stockbridge Plan Commission, by motion of the commission recorded in its official minutes, has recommended the Town Board adopt by resolution the *Town of Stockbridge Expanded Land Use Element* containing all of the required information as specified in section 66.1001(2)(h), Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 4. The Town of Stockbridge has provided numerous opportunities for public involvement in accordance with the public participation strategy adopted by the Plan Commission including numerous public meetings with respect to preparation of the Expanded Land Use Element including a public informational meeting held on November 6, 2006.

SECTION 5. The Town Board of the Town of Stockbridge does, by the passing of this resolution, formally adopt the document entitled, "*Town of Stockbridge Expanded Land Use Element*" and Preferred Land Use Map contained therein.

SECTION 6. The Town Board of the Town of Stockbridge does, by passing of this resolution, authorize the *Town of Stockbridge Expanded Land Use Element* to be included within the *Calumet County Year 2025 Comprehensive Plan*.


