

AMENDMENT--RECYCLING ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWN OF STOCKBRIDGE

1.10 DEFINITIONS. (6) "Major appliance" shall be amended to include residential and commercial furnaces, boilers, dehumidifiers and water heaters (microwave ovens may be landfilled if the capacitor has been removed).

1.14 Shall be amended to more clearly direct specific disposal of lead acid batteries, major appliances, waste oil and tires as follows:

- (1) Lead acid batteries shall be disposed of by the owner of the item by contacting an accepting vendor (such as Farm and Home Supply) or returning the battery to the store of purchase and then delivering the item as directed.
- (2) Major appliances shall be disposed of by the owner of the item by contacting an accepting vendor (such as Stanley Schmitz) and then delivering the item as directed.
- (3) Waste oil shall be disposed of by the owner of the item by contacting an accepting vendor (such as M & N Disposal) and then delivering the item as directed.
- (6) Waste tires shall be disposed of by the owner of the item by contacting an accepting vendor (such as Pat's Tire) and then delivering the item as directed.
