Town Board Minutes
3:00 p.m. Tuesday July 1, 2014
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Supervisor Connie Loewe, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortlieb, Dave Ortlieb, Nick Vande Hey from McMahon and two guests.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The clerk verified that open meeting notices were given.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Connie Yelton. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: Jane Koenen Bretl, representing her parents, addressed the board regarding issues with runoff of mud and water affecting properties on Rockland Beach Road.

Town roads, equipment and buildings: Discussion occurred regarding possible options for Rockland Beach Road. Basic suggestions/calculations will be completed by Nick Vande Hey. A storm water event occurred on June 24 which caused shoulder damage to roads and Artesian Road was closed due to a culvert failure. Yelton gave an update on bridge aid. Yelton said according to the Calumet County Finance Director if the town submitted an application immediately, there is a possibility to obtain emergency bridge aid for Mud Creek Road/Quinney Road bridges. Nick Vande Hey presented information on Quinney Road bridge permitting and plans. Mud Creek bridge is located in a FEMA adopted flood plain, so Vande Hey is waiting for an approved model from FEMA. The board asked Vande Hey to calculate the cost of culvert options for Mud Creek bridge. Costs will be available for our July monthly meeting.

Discussion/possible action on purchase of a new town plow truck: Jerry Ortlieb went through the specifications. The Casper Truck and Equipment bid did not meet the equipment bid specifications. Jeff Yelton made a motion to accept the chassis bid from Quality Truck Center for a Western Star truck per the quote of June 24, 2014. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried. Ken Schaefer made a motion to accept the equipment bid from Monroe Truck with added options of a tool box and automatic chains per the quote of June 24, 2014. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Being no further business Connie Loewe made a motion to adjourn. 2nd by Jeff Yelton. Meeting adjourned 4:09 p.m.
