Monthly Town Board Minutes
7:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 11, 2015
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Supervisor Connie Loewe, Treasurer Ralph Schmid, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortlieb, and 3 town residents.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The clerk verified that open meeting notices were given.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: None

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the January 21, 2015 meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Ortlieb updated the board on roads and equipment.

Policy to apply for No-Fee Permit Application for IoH discussion: The board discussed the policy and map showing roads with weight limits based on road condition. Jeff Yelton made a motion to adopt the Policy to Apply for a No-Fee Permit Application for IoH to Exceed 23K/92/ Weight Table. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Discussion on required Bridge Inspection for Mud Creek Road. Discussion ensued and decision was tabled. Yelton will contact the Calumet County Road Commissioner regarding the inspection.

Discussion on possible Fire Department Bylaw changes: The consensus of the board is that the fire department has to deal with possible bylaw changes and the town has no role to play until bylaw changes are presented to the town and village boards.

Approval of First Responder Officers: Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the First Responder Officers. Seconded by Ken Schaefer. Roll call vote. Yelton Aye, Schaefer Aye, Loewe Abstain. Motion Carried.

The board reviewed the 2014 Financial Statement.

Wisconsin Towns Association District Meeting: The Board discussed possible attendance.

The board voiced no objection to the survey map for N6001 Lakeshore Drive (Parcel ID 10604) Hilbert.

Correspondence/Communications: Bridge Aid application information was received. An email from the Town of Harrison was received regarding a possible study for sewer and water along the lakeshore.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Connie Loewe made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve and pay the bills as presented to the board. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Being no further business Connie Loewe made a motion to adjourn. 2nd by Jeff Yelton. Meeting adjourned 7:57 p.m.
