Monthly Town Board Minutes  
7:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 8, 2015  
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Connie Loewe, Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Treasurer Ralph Schmid, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortlieb, and 2 town residents and guests. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Clerk verified that notices were posted.

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the agenda with #7 Discussion/possible action on town roads, equipment and buildings to after #14 Approval and payment of bills presented to the board. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: None

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the June 10, 2015 meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Discussion/possible action on Quinney Road damage at boat landing: Schaefer contacted Walleyes for Tomorrow regarding damage to the pavement at the Quinney Road boat landing and received no reply. Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve an Application for Temporary Class B Retailer's License for Quinney Fishing Club. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Discussion/possible action on recycling program: The clerk updated the board on the possibility of proposed changes to recycling pickup.

Correspondence/Communications: The board discussed hosting the Towns Association County Unit meeting on July 16, 2015. Yelton addressed an email received from the Village regarding the Fire Department not providing proposed By-Law changes and other information for the Quarterly Town Village joint meeting.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Jeff Yelton made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve and pay the bills as presented to the board. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Ortlieb updated the board on roads and equipment. Discussion of the paving of the community hall/fire department lot occurred. Both the Town and Village have approved the contract with MCC for the paving. Ortlieb was contacted about providing speed limit signs for Grogan's subdivision. Ortlieb and Schaefer have received calls regarding dust issues on Ledge Road. Schaefer opened discussion on Artesian Road and a scheduled meeting with the DNR. Discussion on having a project manager for Quinney Road and Mud Creek bridges occurred.
