Monthly Town Board Minutes
7:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 9, 2016
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Connie Loewe, Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortlieb, Matt Payette of Calumet County Planning, Zoning and Land Information, Gary Zahringer of Martenson and Eisele, Nick VandeHey of McMahon and four town residents.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Clerk verified that notices were posted.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: None

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the February 10, 2016 meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Matt Payette, Director of Calumet County Planning, Zoning and Land Information Department introduced himself and presented upcoming changes to Calumet County Zoning Codes regarding Shoreline Zoning, sign regulations and Wind Energy Facilities required by changes to state law. Payette then fielded questions from the board.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Ortlieb reported that weight limits will go into effect on March 10th. Calumet County sent bridge inspection, bridge aid for 2017 and road stripping information. Schaefer updated the board on Walleye's for Tomorrow and the Quinney Road boat landing damage. Yelton made a motion to send all material regarding damage to the Quinney Road boat landing caused by a Walleye's for Tomorrow project to the town attorney. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Roll Call: Yelton aye, Loewe aye, Schaefer abstain. Motion Carried. Nick Vande Hey updated the board on paperwork received from Baumhardt Sand and Gravel and Joe Mader Excavating regarding the Mud Creek and Quinney Road projects.

A variance for a Certified Survey Map for the Schumacher estate was presented. Schaefer made a motion to support issuing the variance and voiced no objection to the certified survey map. Seconded by Loewe. Motion Carried.

Correspondence/Communications: Communications were reviewed. Discussion of a group water testing program offered by Calumet County occurred. The board will ask town residents at the annual meeting if they are interested in the water testing program.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Jeff Yelton made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve and pay the bills as presented to the board. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Being no further business Jeff Yelton made a motion to adjourn. 2nd by Connie Loewe. Meeting adjourned 7:50 p.m.
