Monthly Town Board Minutes
7:00 p.m. Wednesday, June 8, 2016
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Connie Loewe, Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Treasurer Ralph Schmid, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortlieb and four town residents.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Clerk verified that notices were posted.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: None

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the May 11, 2016 meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Ken Schaefer. Motion Carried.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Ortlieb updated the board regarding equipment and ditch and culvert issues. Ortlieb asked for direction from the board regarding disposal of deer carcasses. The board will look into options. Road work for the Village of Stockbridge was discussed.

Mud Creek Road bridge is scheduled for mid to late July. Schaefer updated the board on paperwork received Joe Mader Excavating regarding the Quinney Road project. The town is waiting for a performance bond from Joe Mader Excavating before the Quinney Road culvert project can go forward. If Mader cannot obtain a performance bond the attorney's advice is the town would need to rebid the project or go to the next contractor. If the project would be rebid, a performance bond for a project under \$50,000 is not required according to Wisconsin State Statutes. Jeff Yelton made a motion to rebid the Quinney Road culvert project with the stipulation that any bid under \$50,000 does not require a performance bond. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Discussion on formation of a committee to explore tax levy options for road improvements and maintenance. The consensus from the board, due to the fact only one person has come forward to volunteer as a committee member, was that the committee will not be formed.

Quinney Road Boat Landing damages: The board proofread the information forwarded from the attorney.

The Village inquired about a Stockbridge Community Emergency Management Plan and if the town would be interested in a collaborative venture. The board discussed the need for information and what services are already available.

The clerk presented Liquor/Beer/Wine/Temporary Beer and Operators License Applications received. Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve a Temporary Class B Retailer's License to Brickyard Fishing Club, Class B Beer and Class B Liquor Licenses to Dwayne Nushardt DBA Fishtale Inn Food-n-Spirits, Hansen Cattle Co. LLC DBA Hansen's Klotten Oasis, Paul Schneider DBA Quinney Quencher, Marcia Klein DBA MAK's Shanty, Boerger Properties, LLC DBA Lakeview Campground, Class B Beer to Winnebago Eastshore Conservation Club, Special Class B Winery License to Edward Rink DBA Quinney Estate Winery LLC and Operator's Licenses to Randall Klein, Leslie Kerklin, Teresa Boerger, Robert Boerger, Brooke Behnke, Bess Jacobs, Cynthia Rolbiecki, Kate Behnke Tanner Behnke and Lydia Pomeroy. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried

Correspondence/Communications: Communications were reviewed. The Wisconsin Towns Association has developed a survey which the clerk was asked to complete.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Jeff Yelton made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve and pay the bills as presented to the board. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Being no further business Connie Loewe made a motion to adjourn. 2nd by Jeff Yelton. Meeting adjourned 7:57 p.m.
