

Town of Stockbridge
Monthly Town Board Minutes
7:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 8, 2017
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Connie Loewe, Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Treasurer Ralph Schmid, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortlieb and three town residents. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Clerk verified that notices were posted.

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: None

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the January meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Jerry Ortlieb updated the board on town work. The town will have enough salt for the season. Schaefer updated the board on the Quinney Road/Walleye's for Tomorrow litigation initiated by the town. Walleye's for Tomorrow has offered a settlement for \$3500. Jeff Yelton made a motion to accept the settlement from Walleye's for Tomorrow/West Bend Insurance for \$3500. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried. Issues at the Mud Creek bridge project were discussed. Yelton stated that he felt that the responsibility of reconciling the problems at Mud Creek needs to be handled by McMahon and he would like representatives from McMahon to attend a board meeting. Jeff Yelton has been contacted by Bob Boerger regarding the plan for the Town to complete chip sealing on Ledge Road in 2017.

Discussion of 2017 town road improvements occurred. Ledge Road chip sealing is estimated to cost about \$60,000. An approximate 1 ½ mile project on Faro Springs Road and available funds were discussed.

Ken Schaefer made a motion to approve the 2017 First Responder Officers as follows: Captain-Connie Loewe, 1st Lt. - Joe Kuhn, 2nd Lt. -Dean Joas, Secretary/Treasurer-Kathy Stadtmueller, Training/Safety-Christie Kuhn, Supplies- Nick Kuhn. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Connie Loewe abstained from voting. Motion Carried.

The board reviewed the 2016 Financial Statement.

The March monthly meeting was changed to March 16, 2017 at 7 p.m.

Correspondence/Communications: Communications were reviewed. Ken Schaefer had communication with the Town of Brothertown Chairman regarding placement of power poles within the Towns of Stockbridge and Brothertown and the need for representation at a Public Service Commission hearing. The town needs to complete a ditch permit for Calumet County.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Connie Loewe made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve and pay the bills as presented to the board. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Being no further business, Connie Loewe made a motion to adjourn. 2nd by Jeff Yelton. Meeting adjourned 7:50 p.m.
