Monthly Town Board Minutes
7:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 10, 2017
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Connie Loewe, Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Treasurer Ralph Schmid, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortlieb and three town residents. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Clerk verified that notices were posted.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: None

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the April meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Jerry Ortlieb updated the board on town work. Gravel has been placed on Ledge Road. A meeting with MCC occurred regarding the paving around the Fire Station/Community Hall. MCC offered to fix around the edge of the building and share the cost of crack filling. Jeff Yelton made a motion not to accept the offer from MCC. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried. The roof on the salt shed will be completed by the end of summer. Large item clean-up exceeded dumpster space and the town had to get a third dumpster. The tires on the backhoe need to be replaced. A quote from Pat's Tire came in at \$2410. The culvert at Ecker Lakeland and Lakeshore Drive needs to be patched due to settling. An estimated cost share with Town of Brothertown would be \$1000 each.

Review and action on operator's licenses received: Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the operator's licenses for Karissa Sanchez and Jennifer Muehlbauer. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried.

The clerk updated the board on Beer/Liquor/Wine/Cigarette/Operator's Licenses received for 2017/2018 licensing year.

Review of the Certified Survey Map for Arthur Woelfel. The Board voiced no objection to the Certified Survey Map for Arthur Woelfel.

Correspondence/Communications: Communications were reviewed. The Clerk and Chairman each received a call from Lisa Martin regarding stray dogs in the Town.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Jeff Yelton made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve and pay the bills as presented to the board. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Being no further business, Connie Loewe made a motion to adjourn. 2nd by Jeff Yelton. Meeting adjourned 7:35 p.m.
