Monthly Town Board Minutes  
7:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 14, 2016  
Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Connie Loewe, Treasurer Ralph Schmid, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Road Supervisor Jerry Ortleib, and five town residents. Supervisor Jeff Yelton was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Clerk verified that notices were posted.

Ken Schaefer made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Public Comment: Ed and Teri Venner appeared before the board regarding consideration of a noise ordinance. The property is along the lakeshore under shoreline zoning therefor Schaefer suggested they contact the county.

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the August 10, 2016 meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Ken Schaefer. Motion Carried.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Ortleib updated the board regarding the parking lot around the fire station and Community Hall. MCC believes that the problem is an oil or mix problem. MCC is experiencing problems with other parking lots which were completed at the same time. Ortleib spoke to the board regarding carbide blades for the new truck due to extended blade life compared to carbon steel. Ortleib will consult with Schaefer before ordering. Ortleib updated the board on requested work from the Village of Stockbridge. Schaefer offered an update on the Quinney Road boat landing issue. Schaefer will meet with the attorney regarding the small claims court action.

Quinney Road culvert project is done with the exception of paving to allow for settling. The Mud Creek Road bridge project is under construction.

The clerk presented applications for Operator's Licenses for Kayla VandenBloomer, Kyle VandenBloomer and Debbie Van Dinter. Connie Loewe made a motion to approve the operator's licenses. Seconded by Ken Schaefer. Motion Carried.

Ken Schaefer made a motion to appoint JoAnn Lakin as a Special Voting Deputy and Special Registration Deputy to cover voting needs while the clerk is unavailable from September 26, 2016 until October 8, 2016 with compensation set at \$100 plus \$5 per voter registration or absentee ballot. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

The Turnout For Transportation meeting at 7 p.m. on September 29<sup>th</sup> at the Calumet County Courthouse Room 25 was discussed.

Discussion on Stockbridge Community Emergency Plan occurred and was tabled.

The voiced no objections to the Certified Survey for Arthur Hoerth.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Connie Loewe made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Ken Schaefer. Motion Carried.

Correspondence/Communications: Communications were reviewed.

Connie Loewe made a motion to approve and pay the bills as presented to the board. Seconded by Ken Schaefer. Motion Carried.

Being no further business Connie Loewe made a motion to adjourn. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ken Schaefer. Meeting adjourned 7:52 p.m.
