David Ortlieb made a motion to adopt the 2017 town tax levy of \$314,224 pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) of the Wisconsin State Statutes. Seconded by Dean Joas. Motion Carried.

Being no further business Ralph Schmid made a motion to adjourn the Special Town Meeting. Seconded by Jeff Yelton. Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned 7:06 p.m.
